The AESIS Network (<http://aesisnet.com/>) has successfully organised the annual conference 'Impact of Science' six times, this year for the first time in Germany. The goal of the conference is the discussion and critical examination of causalities, correlations and preconditions for the different dimensions of scientific impact.
